- Invoices are issued for applicable fees upon receiving a successful enrolment application — payment of the invoice (or nominated minimum amount for By-Choice enrolments) is required before an enrolment can progress.
- Subject and/or resource fee refunds do not apply unless otherwise indicated (*). Conditions may apply.
- Refunds are considered under a ‘grace period’ for enrolments 10 school days or less.
- The fees listed in this document are reviewed annually and are endorsed by the Executive Team and Parent Representative.
- Applicable subject fees and resource fees apply to each student.

Home Schooling By-Choice Fee*	\$1586.50	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Enrolments effective from 1 January 2022 in accordance to the legislation; Section 52 of the Education (General Provisions) Act 2006. • This fee is prescribed under the Education (General Provisions) Regulation 2017 and will increase annually with the Queensland Government indexation rate of 1.8%. • Families under this category can enter in an informal payment plan by paying a minimum of \$750.00, with the provision the remaining balance of (\$836.50) is paid in full by 31 May 2022 (excluding Subject fees). • Enrolments received from 1 June 2022, will be required to pay the full annual fee. • The annual fee is payable regardless the time of enrolment. • In the event that a waiver is submitted and successful, the financial person will receive a refund accordingly and any unpaid balances will have a credit issued against the debt on the student account.

		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Payment plans: Each student enrolling under a home-based by-choice category is offered the payment plan as outlined above. Payment plans and extensions are not available after Semester 1. • Waiver application: Families who are suffering financial hardship may be eligible to apply for a waiver of the Home Schooling fee (subject/resource fees still apply). Applications are considered by the Executive Principal on an individual basis. • Refunds: Students who cancel their enrolment before the end of Semester 1 may be eligible for a pro-rata refund. Applications are considered by the Executive Principal on an individual basis. No refunds apply after Semester 1.

Invoices will be issued for applicable subject fees upon receipt of a completed enrolment application. Subject fees are not due for payment until end of Term 2 for students who enrol before 24 January 2022.

Not all subjects have a cost associated. If a subject is not listed in the table below, fees **do not** apply.

Textbook Resource Allowance (TRA) credits: Parents/caregivers of students who are eligible for this allowance will be advised via email and can choose to use credits in the first instance against any outstanding invoices on the students account (subject fees or Home Schooling Fee), secondly against any extra-curricula activities such as camps, excursions, senior jersey, senior formal.

Students who cancel or complete their schooling where their account is in credit will be issued a refund as an automatic process. Parent/caregivers who have an account in credit and school fees have been settled are entitled to request a refund in writing at any time.

Note: By-Choice students will be required to pay a minimum deposit amount (\$750.00) to allow their enrolment to progress upon submitting their enrolment application.
