### Prep – Year 8 Students

---

Parents/carers will now pay an enrolment deposit via the [Qkr! App or webpage](#) at the time of enrolment. You can then upload the receipt, along with your application form. This deposit will cover the subject and resource fees for 2026 and is refundable if you choose not to finalise your enrolment. Please note that our fees for year 7-10 are reduced by the Department of Education's [Textbook Resource Allowance](#) (TRA) for early bird applications.

### Year 9-12 Students

---

Students enrolling in years 9-12 will again have the option to have their 2026 [Textbook Resource Allowance](#) (TRA) used to cover subject fees. If you agree to this on your enrolment application, your application will be processed without the initial payment of subject and resource fees. Any remaining TRA will be paid to you via refund in second term.

**Please note:** The rate for the TRA does not cover science kits which can be purchased via Qkr! to be despatched. The TRA also does not cover the Cert III in Volunteering or the Cert III in Business, these will be invoiced separately if the student chooses to enrol in these subjects.
