With Aussie teens spending an average of 14.4 hours a week online and 44% of teenagers having a negative online experience, it's so important to stay safe on the internet. Here are some tips to stay safe and have fun: 1. Be kind online. Set an example and show others how to behave. 2. Get consent before sharing a photo or video of another person. 3. Always keep your password a secret. 4. If someone is nasty, offensive or makes you feel uncomfortable online, don't respond. Leave the site straight away. 5. Tell your parents or a trusted adult if you see something upsetting or scary on the internet.
