



The Senior Education and Training (SET) Plan interview has been designed to provide students with the opportunity to discuss the plan they have devised to enable their successful completion of Year 11 and 12. Parents/guardians, teachers and students come together to discuss the student's plan and how the plan is to be implemented. The Plan and interview are required to be completed by all Queensland students and provide a unique partnership opportunity (between parents/guardians, students and the school) to discuss the individual skills and strategies students expect to build upon over the coming two years.

During the interview, you will be expected to put your camera and microphone on, therefore, wear appropriate clothing for a 'job' interview. Come prepared to be an active participant in the conversation.

During the Senior Education and Training (SET) Plan interview, students will be asked the following questions:

- **Why you wish to complete your Senior Schooling at Brisbane School of Distance Education? If you are not choosing to do this, what intended learning option do you wish to do and why?** (This is related to your commitment to your learning)
- **What pathway are you looking for - a QCE plus ATAR, or QCE plus VET or a combination of QCE with VET and ATAR?** (Please also make sure you can explain what QCE, ATAR and VET are.) <https://www.qcaa.qld.edu.au/senior/new-snr-assessment-te>
- **What are the subjects you have chosen for next year? How do they complement your skills and characteristics?** (Please ensure you have completed the OneSchool subject selections sections of the My Education Plan.)
- **Have you spoken to your parents about these subjects? Have you spoken about your OneSchool My Education Plan? Have you chosen subjects that you have met Recommendations for Success for?** (Check Recommendations for Success to select subjects then make a wish list for others you don't meet but would like to do. Ensure you discuss the wish list at the meeting)

- **Have you considered which industries you would like to work in, after leaving school? What level of education is required to secure education in this field? What is your general area of interest?** <https://myfuture.edu.au/bullseyes>
- **What strategies are you going to implement to achieve your desired goals from your SET Plan?** (Consider your everyday behaviours for time-management, health and sleep management, extra-curricular activities including work and volunteering.)
- **In what ways do the subjects you selected support you to achieve your goals? Why those subjects?** (Are they prerequisite needed for further study or just helpful skills to get a job in an area of interest?)

Discuss these responses before your interview with your parent/guardian.
