Education QLD requires distance education students to provide evidence that they're still eligible to enrol under their specific enrolment category each year.



Failure to return these forms and pay fees will result in the student not being enrolled to commence classes for the beginning of the school year.



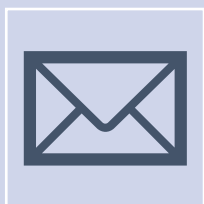
To ensure the student is enrolled to start on the first day of 2025, please return enrolment forms and pay fees by the **14th November, 2024**. All enrolment applications are processed in date order of receipt. Students are timetabled into classes in date order of payment received. Students are placed in classes where capacity allows.

Returning-Continuing Enrolments

The information included on this page is for continuing enrolments. E.g. Students continuing their studies with BrisbaneSDE from this year (2024) into next year (2025).

We are a distance education school. It is mandatory for applicants to provide evidence that they continue to meet the eligibility requirements to enrol under their enrolment category. It is a requirement that applications are completed every year the student is enrolled at a distance education school. **Failure to return** applications will result in the student **not** being enrolled to start classes for the beginning of the 2025 school year. BrisbaneSDE process applications in order of receipt and timetable students in order of payment received. Students are placed in classes where capacity allows.

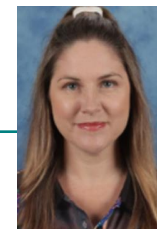

Y10 subject choices & results impact options in Y11 and 12

- Studying **Foundation Maths** or **Foundation English** for Y10 will **limit** subject selection in Y11 and 12 to Essential Maths or Essential English
- A B or above in Y10 Standard Maths or English are required for **general subjects** in Y11 and 12 (these give a university entry score)
- To choose general subjects in Y11 and 12 students need to be achieving at least a B in relevant Y10 subjects
 - **Design** – B or above in Year 9 or Year 10 Design, and a C or above in Year 10 English
 - **Psychology** – B or above in Year 10 English, Science and Mathematics (Standard).
 - **Physics** – B or above in Year 10 Science and Mathematics Extension
 - **Legal Studies** – B or above in Year 10 English and a Humanities and Social Science subject
 - **French** - Year 10 French based on the Australian Curriculum or the equivalent level is essential, with a C or above, preferably a B

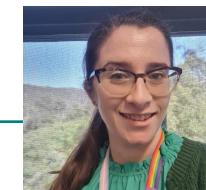
LEGEND: ■ Year 10 Core ■ Year 10 Elective ■ Years 11-12 General ■ Years 11-12 Applied ■ VET
