

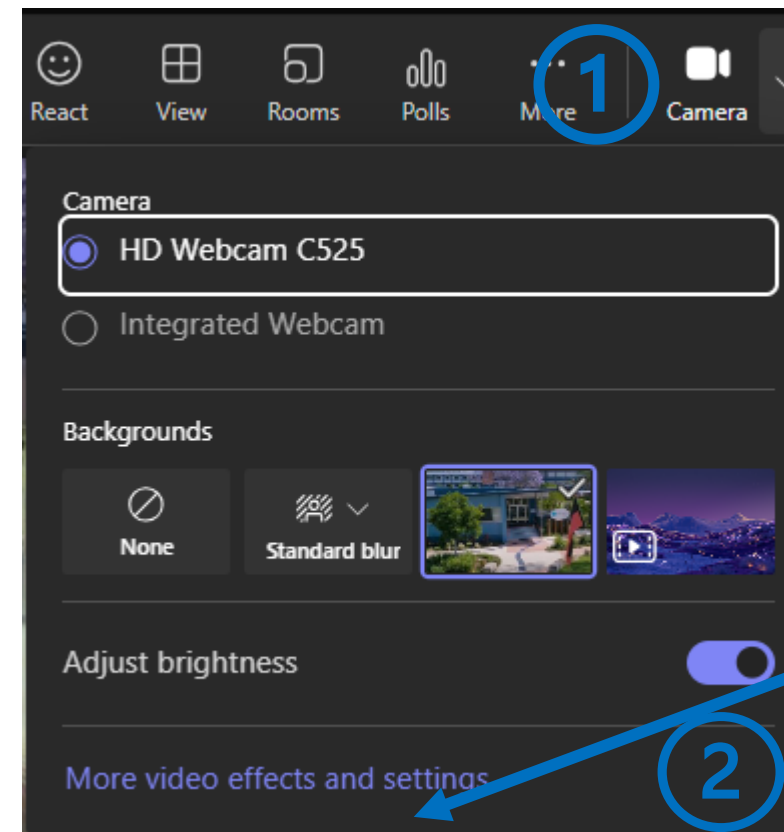

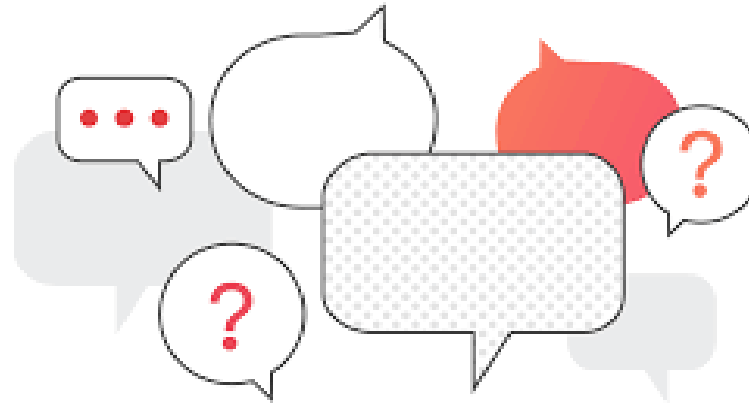

Expectations for Year 11

- All students study 6 learning options (as per approved SET P)
- Attendance is required at all online lessons
- Every student must be on track to achieve a QCE or QCIA at the end of Year 12
- Some students will be ATAR eligible
- BrisbaneSDE is bound by QCAA policy and procedures:
 - Every assessment is mandatory
 - Assessments cannot be modified or adjusted
 - Responses must be submitted by the due date, or they don't count.
- Need to provide an exam supervisor



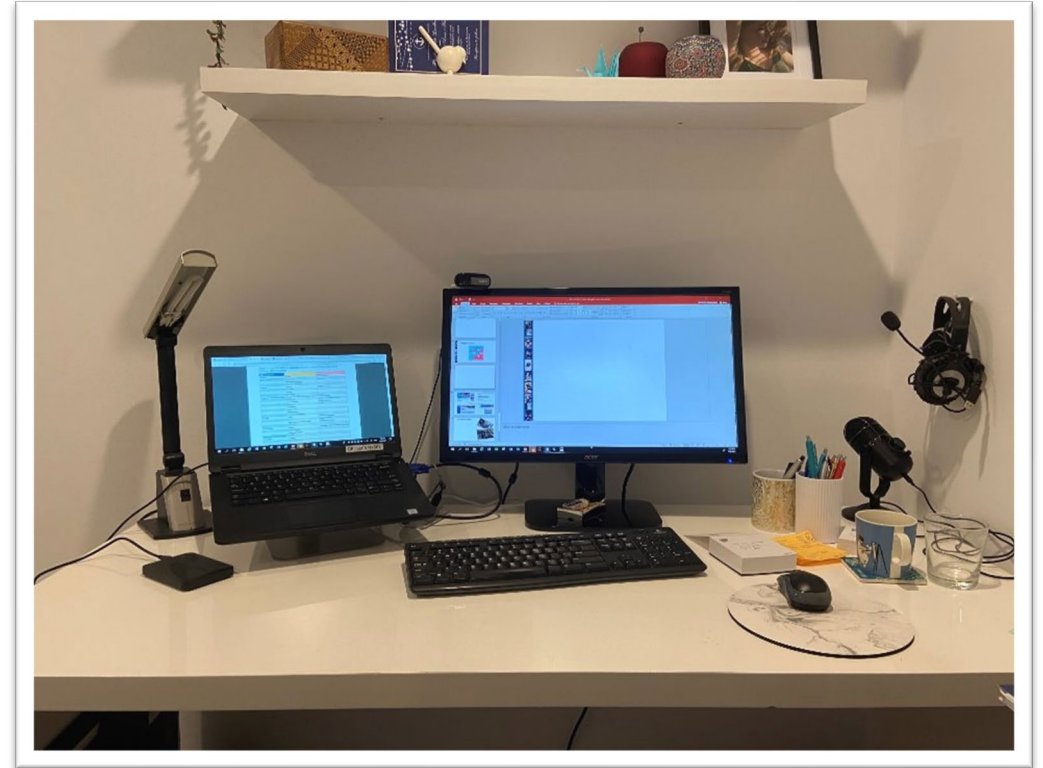
AARA (Access arrangements and reasonable adjustments)

- We can only make adjustments in accordance with QCAA policy
- Adjustments must be specifically recommended by a medical practitioner, and the reason fully explained
- Reasonable adjustments from Year 10 may not be granted in Year 11/12
- Many adjustments require QCAA approval, so thorough documentation is required

- Have realistic expectations and minimise stress





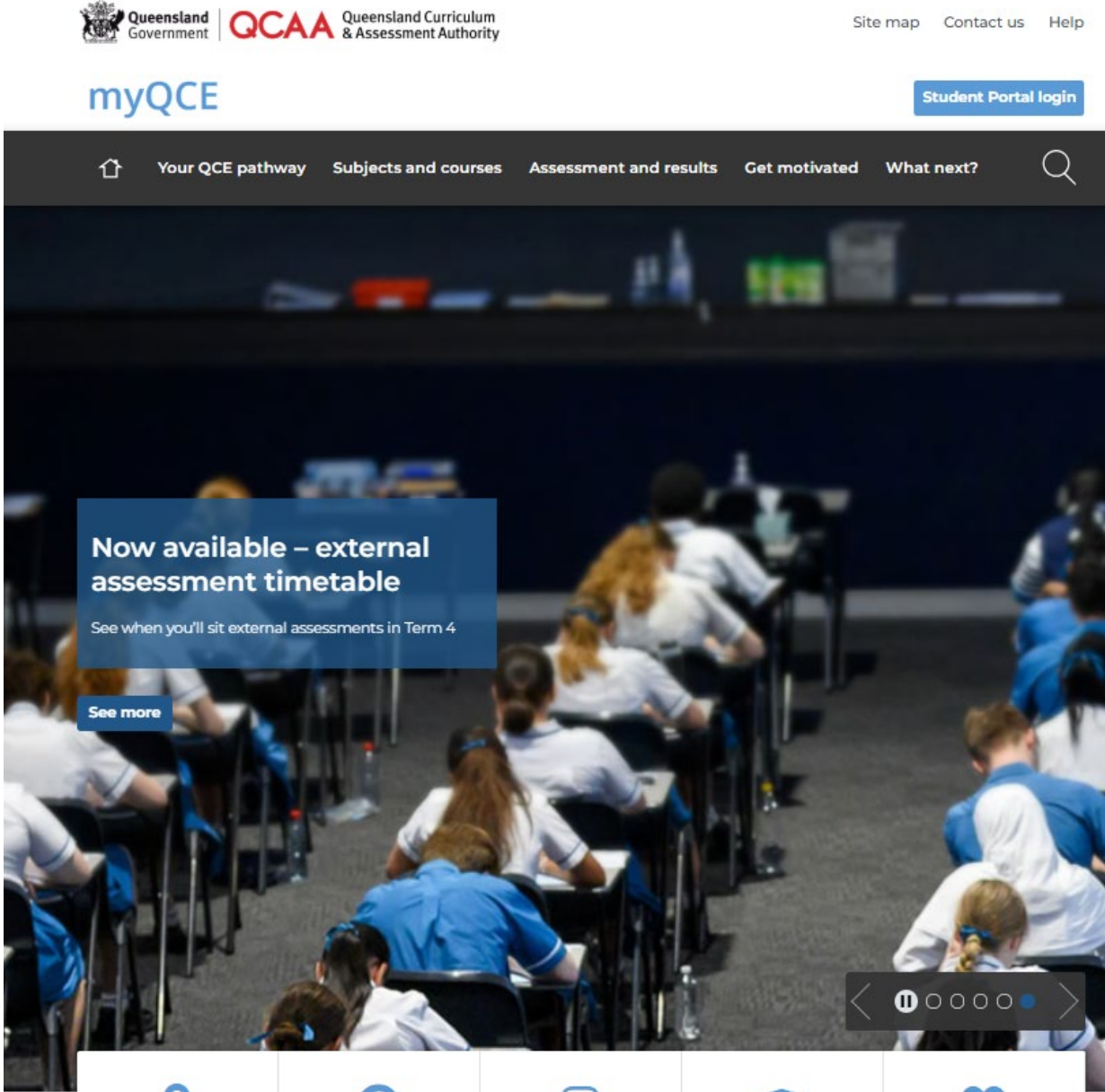

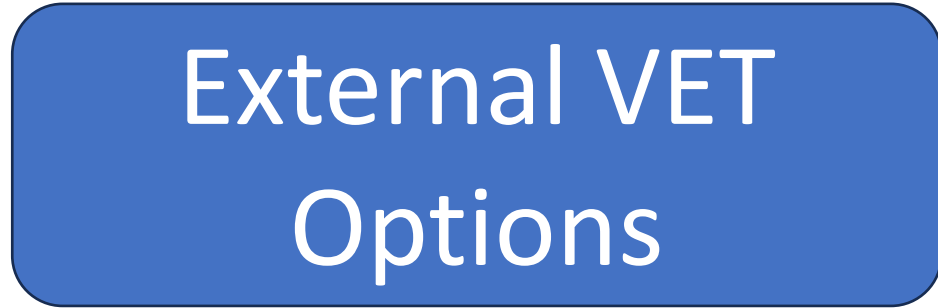

- For a neurodiverse student who is homebound, finding options to study courses of interest which take them out of their comfort zone and security of the family home is invaluable, and made all the difference with our child's future employment and career pathway.
- Teacher, *** has been excellent. My student gets on really well with *** and has built a fantastic relationship with him, which is great considering my student has past trauma from unkind teachers. We give *** a massive high five. Really hoping my student has *** again next year when he continues his certificate studies.
- My student found something they are interested in and this had improved their attitude towards learning and given them a goal outside of School that will hopefully lead to a job they enjoy.

How does External VET fit into my student's timetable?

- After your student has attended at least 2 weeks of lessons with the RTO, they email the VET Team to let us know how they are going. If they are confident that they will continue with the external VET study – then at that point, we can discuss removing a subject from their timetable.
- As a result of the above 🙌 every student who is undertaking external VET study in 2026, will essentially start the year on 6 BrisbaneSDE subjects, plus their external VET.
- If your student is CONTINUING with external VET study from 2025 – 2026, they can email the VET Team prior to week 1 of Term 1, 2026 to confirm their intention to continue with the external VET study. We can then arrange to drop the subject as early as possible.
- The external VET study will NOT appear on their timetable.
- If they are required to attend face-to-face or online classes for their external VET study during school time, the students will be put on an Attendance Plan – which means they'll be marked off as an 'explained absence'. The students will then be required to watch the lesson recordings of missed classes. Once their subject has been dropped, they'll have extra time in their timetable to assist with this. They will develop their time management skills!

External VET – FUNDING

The Department of Trade, Employment and Training – DTET – controls the funding for VET qualifications as well as traineeships/apprenticeships for students who are at school and for people who have left school.

Whilst at school, a student can access VETiS funding ONCE for a VETiS funded qualification:

Only certain Certificate II level qualifications are VETiS funded. These are listed on the [Queensland Subsidized Training List](#).

Depending on eligibility, students can access funding for certain Certificate III, IV and Diploma level qualifications once they have left school. You can read about this here -

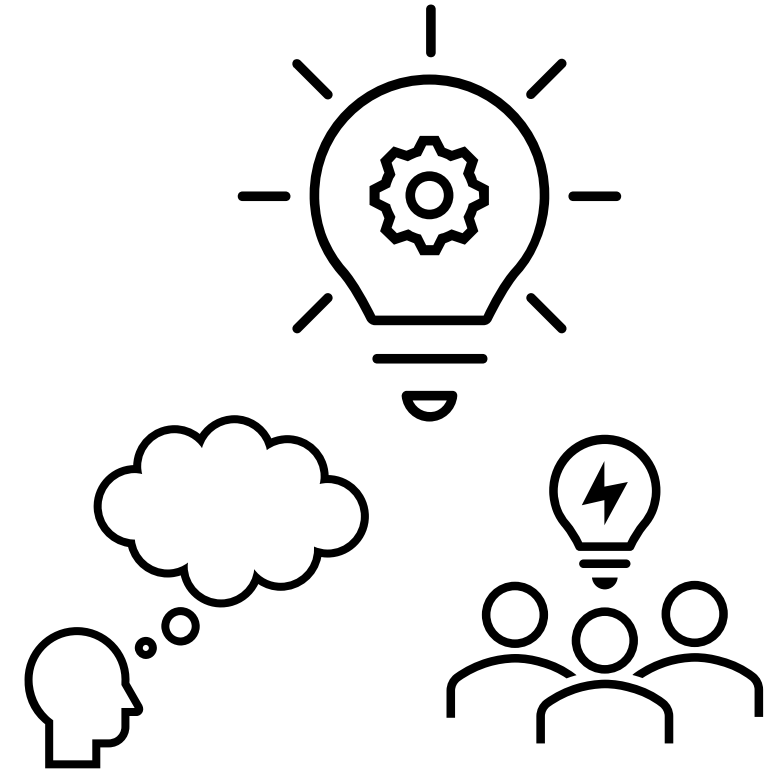

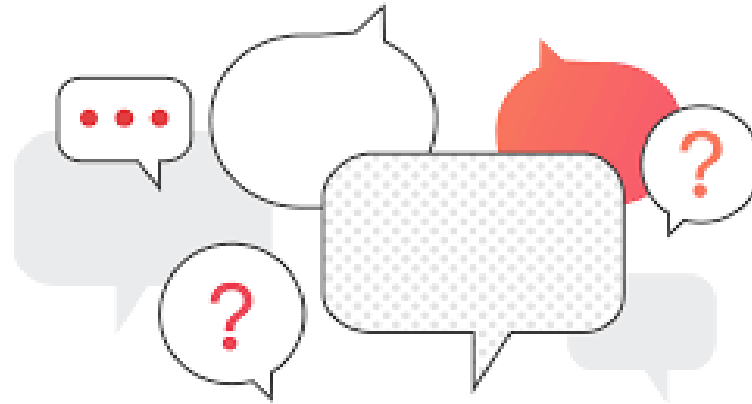
