

## Statement of Fees: Home-based students

- Invoices are issued for applicable Resource and Subject Fees after receiving a successful enrolment application — payment of the Resource and Subject Fees is required before an enrolment can progress.
- It is highly recommended that an initial deposit of \$800.00 is paid towards the Home Schooling Fee at the same time Resource and Subject Fees are paid to reduce your financial burden later in the year. Home Schooling Fees only apply to By Choice enrolment category enrolments. If you are uncertain about what enrolment category your student is in please check with the Enrolments Team.
- Subject and/or resource fee refunds do not apply unless otherwise indicated (\*). Conditions may apply.
- Refunds of Resource and Subject Fees are considered under a 'grace period' for enrolments 10 school days or less
- The fees listed in this document are reviewed annually and are endorsed by the Executive Team and Parent Representative.
- Applicable Resource and Subject Fees apply to each student.

		This fee is prescribed under the Education (General Provisions) Regulation 2017 and will increase annually.
		The annual fee is payable regardless the time of enrolment.
		In the event that a waiver is submitted and successful, the financial person will receive a refund accordingly and any unpaid balances will have a credit issued against the debt on the student account.

#### Payment plans, waiver applications and refunds

- There are no payment plans or waivers available for Resource and Subject Fees. Resource and Subject Fees
  must be paid before an enrolment will progress to the stage where it is finalised.
- Payment plans: Families who choose to make an initial deposit of \$800 when paying their Resource and Subject Fees will enter into a default payment plan option whereby they will be given until 31 May 2024 to pay the outstanding balance of the Home Schooling Fee.
- Waiver application: Families who are suffering financial hardship may be eligible to apply for a waiver of the Home Schooling Fee (subject/resource fees still apply). Applications are considered by the Executive Principal on an individual basis.
- Refunds: Students who cancel their enrolment before the end of Semester 1 may be eligible for a pro-rata
  refund of the Home Schooling Fee. Applications are considered by the Executive Principal on an individual
  basis. No refunds apply after Semester 1.

\$200.00

A security deposit of \$200.00 is required for new enrolments for Supplementary reading packs and Reading resources provided to families. Payment will be required to ensure you receive the essential learning packages for Primary lessons in 2024. Continuing students with a full \$200.00 deposit balance will have it carried over from the previous year.

Deposits are fully refundable. The following conditions apply:

- Resources are to be returned at the end of each term.
- Families receiving the packs are responsible for the issued resources and all must be returned in good condition.
- In the event a student cancels before the end of the school year, the deposit
  will be refunded when loans have been confirmed as being returned in good
  condition or not despatched.
- Eligible refunds will be issued upon cancellation of enrolment/graduation from Primary school once it has been confirmed all materials have been returned.

Deposits will be retained partially or in-full and applied accordingly against invoices raised to replace any lost or damaged resources in the returned packages.

We highly recommend that families use the Australia Post tracking option when returning these resources for their own insurance as resources are the family's responsibility until received by our Resource Centre.

Note: Invoices will be issued for:

- · any resources that are not returned after reminder notices have been issued
- · for items that are returned damaged.
