^{*}Music: Students selecting Music are required to have a musical instrument. It is highly recommended that students have access to a keyboard instrument (e.g. glockenspiel, keyboard, piano). It is mandatory that student have achieved a B or above standard in Year 9 music or equivalent, for example, Grade 2 AMEB theory.

BrisbaneSDE requires evidence to show that the student has met the prerequisite for Music and/or Languages, i.e. Report card, letter from private school, Diagnostic Test.



^{**}Languages: Select a language only if prerequisites have been met. Completion of Year 9 language based on the Australian Curriculum is essential with an achievement of C or above. Online lessons are compulsory for Language subjects. Languages cover a whole-year of study (2 semesters).
